BEMENT COMMUNITY UNIT SCHOOL DISTRICT 5
SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION
JANUARY 24, 2019

The special meeting of the Bement Community Unit School District 5 Board of Education was held Thursday, January 24, 2019 in the high school library. The meeting was called to order by board president Kyle Rogers at 6:57 p.m.

Board members present were Kyle Rogers, Layna Somers, Jeff Funk, Trixie Stoerger-Flavin, Janice Fogerson, Denise Strack and Todd Scott.

There was an open discussion between the two boards regarding the possibility of co-oping middle school sports and potentially cross country for middle and high school. There was also a discussion regarding some of the issues that have arisen from the high school sports co-op.

The board presidents were instructed to contact their respective superintendents and discuss the option of the board presidents' meetings with the athletic directors from both schools.

Both boards agreed this was a good opportunity to discuss some of the issues that have arisen in the high school sports that are co-oped with both athletic directors. It was agreed that after this meeting the athletic directors would work on solutions and then both boards would meet again, possibly in the middle of March. No date was set at this time.
