(Children do not have to be registered readers or have a Library Card to participate in Library programs and events.)

- ⇒ Start counting your minutes or books on June 1, the first day of the program.
- ⇒ Stop counting your minutes or books on July 27, when the summer reading program ends.
- ⇒ Turn in your log by August 3 to be included in the Grand Prize Raffle drawing and/or recognized as a Top Reader.

Reading logs available and prizes awarded for age groups:

- 3 years (as of June 1) to Kindergarteners
- 1st Grade to 5th Grade
- 6th Grade to 12th Grade (use Teen Reading Log)
