A motion was made by Rogers and seconded by Strack that the board approve the resolution providing for the issue of General Obligation School Bonds, Series 2017A, of the District, for the purpose of paying claims against the District, refunding certain outstanding obligations of the District, altering and reconstructing school buildings and purchasing and installing equipment therein for fire prevention and safety, energy conservation and school security purposes, providing for the levy of a direct annual tax sufficient to pay the principal and interest on said bonds, and authorizing the sale of said Bonds to the purchaser thereof. Motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.

A motion was made by Rogers and seconded by Funk that the board approve the resolution providing for the issue of Taxable General Obligation School Bonds, Series 2017B (Qualified Zone Academy Bonds), of the District, for the purpose of altering and reconstructing school buildings and purchasing and installing equipment therein for fire prevention and safety, energy conservation and school security purposes, providing for the levy of a direct annual tax sufficient to pay the principal and interest on

said bonds, and authorizing the sale of said Bonds to the purchaser thereof. Motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.

A motion was made by Fogerson and seconded by Stoerger-Flavin that the board accept the resignation of Wendy Brown. Motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.

A motion was made by Strack and seconded by Funk that the board approve the employment of Annie Galindo as a kindergarten teacher for the 2017-2018 school year. Motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.

A motion was made by Stoerger-Flavin and seconded by Scott that the board approve the employment of Elizabeth White as a first grade teacher for the 2017-2018 school year. Motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.

A motion was made by Scott and seconded by Strack that the board adjourn at 7:26 p.m. Motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.
